On multiple occasions between April 8, 2014 and November 13, 2014, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Chevron Pipeline Company (CPL) procedures for operations and maintenance in Bellaire, TX and facilities throughout the West Texas area. As a result of the inspection, CPL was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 17, 2015, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
