On May 18, 2015, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Enterprise Crude Pipeline's (Enterprise) procedures in Houston, TX. As a result of the inspection, Enterprise was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 10, 2015, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Enterprise submitted its amended procedures on August 4, 2015. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
