Dear Mr. Shamla:

On multiple occasions between July 23, 2012 and April 20, 2015, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code conducted onsite inspections of the Enbridge Storage (Cushing) L.L.C (Enbridge) terminal in Cushing, Oklahoma, specifically procedures and records related to the Enbridge BP/Amoco Pipe Modification Project. As a result of these inspections, on August 25, 2015, a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order (Notice) was issued to Enbridge Storage (Cushing), LLC (Enbridge, the Operator).

On March 24, 2017, a Final Order was issued with a Compliance Order requiring the Operator to perform specified corrective actions, along with a civil penalty in the amount of \$33,100. Enbridge paid the penalty, performed the specified corrective actions, and on August 26, 2019, requested closure of the case. Representatives of PHMSA performed inspections and found the corrective actions to be acceptable.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
