Between February 1, 2016 and March 18, 2016, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Kinetica Energy Express LLC (Kinetica) procedures in Lake Charles, LA. As a result of the inspection, Kinetica was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 18, 2016, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Kinetica submitted its amended procedures on August 5 & 17, 2016. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
