On April 15, 2015, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an accident investigation and reviewed documentation related to the accident at the T Station in Eddy County, New Mexico. As a result of the inspection, Western Refining Pipeline, LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 15, 2016 which proposed amendment of your procedures.
