Between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2016, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (USC) inspected Navajo Nation Oil and Gas (NNOGC) records and procedures.

As a result of these inspections, a Notice of Probable Violation, CPF 4-2017-5009 was issued on April 6, 2017. On May 9, 2017, NNOGC responded to the NOPV and submitted a copy of the NNOGC Response Plan for PHMSA review.

My staff has reviewed your plan and found it to adequately meet the requirements of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 194.107. Subsequently, this letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary and the case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
