On November 14 through 17, 2016, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected EnVen Energy Ventures, LLC (EnVen) procedures for Operations and Maintenance of the Cognac Pipeline Offshore Liquid System located offshore Louisiana. As a result of the inspection, EnVen was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 6, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
