Between January 24 and February 24, 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Cheniere Corpus Christi Pipeline procedures in Houston, TX.
