During the months of April 11-13, 2017 to October 12, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected the Targa Resources Operating LLC (Targa), Offshore Pelican/Seahawk Gas System in OCS-Gulf of Mexico. As a result of the inspection, Targa was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 3, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Targa submitted amended procedures on July 23, 2018. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Admendment have been corrected.
