
Dear Mr. Amundsen:

From January 5, 2018 to July 6, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Energy Transfer's procedures in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Energy Transfer was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 23, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Energy Transfer submitted its amended procedures on November 15, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
