From June 13- 30, 2016, representatives of the Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), Southwest Region, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a pipeline safety inspection of Targa NGL Pipeline Company (Targa), facilities and records pertaining to the Product Pipeline system with pipelines in Louisiana and Texas. As a result of the inspection, Targa was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 14, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Targa submitted its amended procedures on April 30, 2019. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
