On April 16, 2018 through April 28, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of UCAR Pipeline Incorporated's (UCAR) procedures in Angleton, Texas. As a result of the inspection, UCAR was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 22, 2019.
