From June 25 through September 26, 2019, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Freeport LNG Development, L.P.'s (FLNG) procedures for its natural gas transmission pipeline system located in Freeport, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Freeport LNG Development, L.P.'s (FLNG) was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 28, 2020.

FLNG's amended procedures were received by PHMSA on February 10, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
