From March 16, 2020 through October 2, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a virtual pipeline safety inspection of Florida Gas Transmission Company's (FGT) procedures via video teleconference. As a result of the inspection, FGT was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 17, 2021, which proposed amendments of your procedures.

FGT submitted its amended procedures on September 16, 2021 and October 14, 2021. PHMSA staff has reviewed these procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
