From March 29, 2021 through June 8, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a pipeline safety inspection of Midship Pipeline Company, LLC's (Midship) procedures for operations, maintenance, and emergencies in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Midship was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 1, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
