From March 3, 2021, to October 28, 2021, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C), inspected Genesis Offshore Holdings, LLC's (Genesis) procedures for construction, integrity management, operations and maintenance in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Genesis was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 8, 2022, which proposed amendments to Genesis' procedures.

Genesis submitted its amended and supplementary procedures on May 2, 2022, and August 24, 2022, respectively. PHMSA staff reviewed these procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
