CPL has assumed the date of its response of completion of the CO issues, September 1, 2008, as the date of receipt of the Final Order.

**Compliance Order No. 4**

- ❖ CPL must provide PHMSA's Western Regional Director with a complete list of corrective actions identified by their internal, external processes or other means, and indicate if it was implemented or not and supporting reasons for their actions on each potential corrective action identified for the next 5 years from receipt of the final order on a annual basis, but no later than January 31 of each year.

Between September 1 and December 31, 2008 no potential corrective action items were identified by internal, external processes or other means.
