Dear Mr. Liedtke:

On March 4, 2008 the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Windsor Energy Group LLC a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order in the above-referenced case. Based on our review of the documentation you provided, it has been determined that the non-rural segment of your Bennett Creek gathering line is a gravity line and is therefore not under the jurisdiction of 49 CFR Part 195. However, if you should install pumps or other mechanisms that introduce pressure to this pipeline, that non-rural segment of the Bennett Creek gathering line will then be subject to all of the applicable sections of 49 CFR Part 195.

Accordingly, this case has been withdrawn and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
