On July 6-9, 2009, July 21, 2009, and August 12, 2009, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Alyeska Pipeline Service Company's (Alyeska) procedures for the Alyeska Fuel Gas Line in Fairbanks and Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Alyeska was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 23, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Alyeska submitted its amended procedures on April 22, 2010 and July 9, 2010. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
