On March 19-23, 2012, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Kinder Morgan's procedures in Colorado Springs, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, Kinder Morgan was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 3, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
