On March 20-23, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Aircraft Service International Group (ASIG) procedures in Honolulu, Hawaii. As a result of the inspection, ASIG was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 31, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

ASIG submitted its amended procedures on May 22, 2013 and June 12, 2013. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
