Dear Mr. True:

Between November 14, 2011 and March 9, 2012, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, investigated a November 14, 2011 release from your Sussex Diesel Pipeline System's Davis Station southwest of Gillette, Wyoming. The release spilled 1900 barrels of diesel onto the ground causing contamination to the soil.

As a result of the investigation, Belle Fourche Pipeline Company (BFPL) was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 19, 2014, which proposed amendment of your procedures. BFPL submitted revised procedures for its Operations and Maintenance Manual and for its Control Room Manual on March 23, 2014, and April 23, 2014, respectively. My staff reviewed BFPL's response and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
