DCP Midstream, LP ("DCP") has received the Notice of Amendment CPF 5-2014-6001M, arising out of the inspection of operations, maintenance and emergency procedures conducted by PHMSA's Western Region in November 2012. The attachments provide DCP's response to the specific findings of the Notice as well as supporting documentation.

DCP does not contest the item listed in the Notice of Amendment, which concerned procedures for the periodic review of work in order to ensure the effectiveness and adequacy of operations and maintenance procedures, as required by 49 CFR 402(c)(13). However, DCP notes that the DCP procedural manual did in fact include such periodic review procedures at the time of the inspection; a copy is attached to this letter. DCP's representatives at this inspection were not sufficiently familiar with the documentation of these procedures to produce them to the inspector. For this reason, DCP will address this finding with additional training for compliance and operations personnel rather than a revision of its procedures.
