On November 14 – 15, 2012, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of DCP Midstream's procedures in Greeley, Colorado. As a result of the inspection, DCP Midstream was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 5, 2014, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

DCP Midstream submitted its response concerning the need to amend its procedures on April 7, 2014. My staff reviewed DCP Midstream's response, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
