On March 23, 2015, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Hilcorp Alaska procedures in Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Hilcorp Alaska was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 3, 2015, which proposed amendment of procedures.

Hilcorp Alaska submitted its amended procedures on December 4, 2015. My staff has reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
