On October 20-24 and October 27-30, 2014, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Hawaii Gas' Distribution Integrity Management Program (DIMP) procedures in Honolulu, Hawaii. As a result of the inspection, Hawaii Gas was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 28, 2016, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Hawaii Gas submitted its amended procedures on August 26, 2016. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
