Dear Ms. Moy:

On October 20-24, 2014 and October 27-30, 2014, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Hawaii Gas' Operations and Maintenance Procedures Manual and Integrity Management Program Procedures that cover its 22.6 mile synthetic natural gas (SNG) transmission pipeline system on the island of Oahu, Hawaii. As a result of the inspection, Hawaii Gas was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 15, 2016, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Hawaii Gas submitted its amended procedures on December 16, 2016. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and supporting documents. It appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
