Dear Mr. Cantrall:

On April 14, 2016, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Freeport-McMoRan Oil & Gas (Freeport) a Consent Order incorporating the terms of the Consent Agreement between PHMSA and Freeport in the above-referenced case. This Order included a requirement to take corrective actions on your 20-inch crude oil pipeline from Platform Irene to the Lompoc Oil & Gas Plant facility near Lompoc, California. Based on our review of the documentation you provided on May 27, 2016 and the verification during the physical inspection of the site by a PHMSA inspector on August 17, 2016, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of the Order and the Consent Agreement.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
