Dear Mr. Hoidal:

Suncor Energy (U.S.A.) Pipeline Company ("Suncor") is in receipt of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration's ("PHMSA") Warning Letter (the "Letter") CPF 5-2017-5001W, dated February 24, 2017. The Letter relates to the inspection of Suncor's Rocky Mountain Pipeline System located in Wyoming and Colorado, conducted in Cheyenne, Wyoming on June 2, August 14, November 14-17, and December 12-13, 2016.

The Letter states that Suncor failed to maintain current maps and records of its pipeline systems because Block Valves 8023.3E and 8G23.3W (the "Block Valves") on Suncor's parallel 8-inch diameter East and West crude oil pipelines appeared on the alignment drawings for the Rocky Mountain Crude Pipeline System, but both Block Valves have been removed.

Suncor understands that the Letter did not result in actual findings of violations or penalties and that the case was considered closed upon issuance of the Letter. Suncor hereby confirms that the alignment drawings for the Rocky Mountain Crude Pipeline System have been corrected to remove the Block Valves.

Suncor does want to correct the addressee of the Letter. The Letter is addressed to Suncor Energy Inc., which is the incorrect company. The Rocky Mountain Pipeline System is owned by Suncor Energy (U.S.A.) Pipeline Company, which is a separate corporate entity from Suncor Energy Inc. The correct contact information is:
