On December 15, 2016, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected your Endicott crude oil pipeline facilities located near Deadhorse, Alaska. Prior to that trip, supporting operation and maintenance procedures, and implementation records were reviewed on November 22-23, 2016 at your Anchorage office. As a result of the inspection, Hilcorp was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 5, 2017 which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Hilcorp submitted its amended procedures on May 4, 2017. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
