From September 2016 through March 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of DCP Operating Company's (DCP) procedures in Colorado and Kansas. As a result of the inspection, DCP was issued a Notice of Amendment on June 26, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
