DCP Operating Company, LP ("DCP", formerly named DCP Midstream, LP), has received your Notice of Amendment dated June 26, 2017 regarding an apparent inadequacy in DCP's written operating procedures for the Wattenberg to Bushton highly volatile liquids pipeline system located in Colorado and Kansas. Specifically, the notice states that DCP's external corrosion control procedures do not address the circumstances under which a close interval survey (CIS) may be performed in accordance with 49 CFR 195.573(a)(2) other than during the first two years of operation or for segments that could affect a high consequence area.

DCP has revised its procedures H-10, External Corrosion Monitoring, and CORR-2200, Application of Cathodic Protection Criteria, to clarify that CIS may be practicable when adequate cathodic protection cannot be demonstrated, in addition to the circumstances previously addressed in these procedures. Please see the attached revised procedures.
