On several occasions between February 14, 2017 and April 14, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected the Pacific Operators Offshore LLC (PACOPS)'s Operations and Maintenance (O&M) procedures in La Conchita, California. As a result of the inspection, PACOPS was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 3, 2017 which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Documents submitted by PACOPS on August 9th, 2017 and October 5th, 2017 to PHMSA had been reviewed by my staff and determined that PACOPS has now fully complied with all the remedial requirements set forth in the NOA.
