On several occasions between July 31, 2017 and August 3, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Plains Marketing, L.P.'s, a subsidiary of Plains All American Pipeline, LP, (Plains) 6-inch gas distribution pipeline system that serves Martinez Terminal in Concord, California. As a result of the inspection, Plains was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on January 25, 2018 which proposed amendment of your procedures.

On February 21, 2018, Plains responded to the Notice and informed PHMSA that Plains no longer owns and operates the pipeline.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
