On March 12, 2018, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) and Arizona Corporation Commission, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Dominion Energy Questar Pipeline's (DEQP) procedures for operation and maintenance in Salt Lake City, Utah. As a result of the inspection, DEQP was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 17, 2018, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

DEQP submitted its amended procedures on September 20, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
