

Dear Mr. Hubbard:

TransColorado Gas Transmission Company LLC (TransColorado) is in receipt of PHMSA's Warning Letter dated September 18, 2019 (the "Letter") alleging violations of the Pipeline Safety Regulations in 49 CFR Part 192. As noted in the Letter, TransColorado undertook corrective actions during the inspection. Specifically, the removed pipe which was the subject of the alleged violation was still available for inspection. TransColorado personnel performed both an internal and external inspection and found no significant corrosion.

As set out in the Letter, no further corrective action is required. TransColorado is committed to pipeline safety and appreciates the opportunity to work with PHMSA to resolve the concerns.
