From August 26 through 28, 2019, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected and reviewed DCOR LLC's (DCOR) procedures for the crude oil transmission pipeline system that serves your offshore Platform A and the Rincon Onshore Separation Facility (RSOF) in Ventura, California. As a result of the inspection, DCOR was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 3, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

DCOR submitted its amended procedures on March 13, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
