Dear Mr. White:

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued the above referenced Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to SFPP, L.P. (SFPP) on May 12, 2021, alleging seven violations, two of which were warning items. SFPP timely responded to the NOPV, contesting two of the alleged violations and requesting a hearing. At the same time, SFPP requested the opportunity to meet with PHMSA to attempt to resolve the issues without resort to a hearing. Following a settlement meeting, exchange of information, and additional discussions, SFPP and PHMSA reached an agreement to resolve the matter as reflected in the Consent Agreement that the parties entered into, effective on October 22, 2021. Given the memorialization of the parties' agreement in the Consent Order and Agreement, SFPP hereby withdraws its Request for Hearing regarding the above referenced NOPV.
