Closure Letter**

Dear Mr. McClure:

From March 4, 2021, to May 18, 2021, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Company (NNOGC) PHMSA Drug and Alcohol (D&A) written plan and procedures by virtual and other electronic means. During the inspection, PHMSA identified apparent inadequacies within NNOGC's written D&A plan and procedures.

The PHMSA Western Region received and reviewed the amended written D&A plan and procedures NNOGC submitted to PHMSA in correspondence dated July 23, 2021, and we find them adequate. This letter is to inform you that NNOGC has complied with the terms of the Notice of Amendment (NOA) and that no further actions are necessary with regards to the NOA. This case is now closed.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the NOA (**CPF 5-2021-034-NOA**) and not to other PHMSA pending cases, if any. Also be advised that nothing herein states or implies that the above described written D&A plan and procedures meet the requirements of the federal pipeline safety regulations or that the NNOGC written D&A plan and procedures are approved. The NNOGC D&A program remains subject to inspection by PHMSA.
