From June 4, 2019 through January 7, 2020, an inspector from the Virginia State Corporation Commission, acting as Agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of the City of Richmond's (City) procedures in Richmond, VA. As a result of the inspection, the City was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 24, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
