From April 9, 2019 to April 11, 2019, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Shell Pipeline Co., L.P. (Shell)'s Falcon Ethane Pipeline construction project in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, Shell was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 16, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
