Dear Mr. Cayton:

From May 19 to 20, 2020, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Cranberry Pipeline Corporation's (CPC) Heizer Creek Storage and Maxton underground natural gas storage facilities (UNGSF) in Putnam County and Raleigh County, West Virginia. Effective May 27, 2020, CPC divested operatorship of these UNGSFs to Diversified Midstream LLC (Diversified). Diversified retained the procedures of Cranberry Pipeline Corp. for its own use. As a result of the inspection, Diversified was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 11, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Diversified submitted its amended procedures on May 4, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
