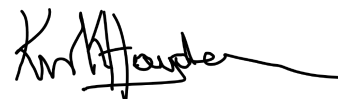
From November 23, 2020 to November 25, 2020, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (“PHMSA” or the “Administration”) conducted an onsite inspection of the Hopkinton Liquefier Project owned by Hopkinton LNG Corp. (“Eversource” or the “Company”) as part of the ongoing Liquefier Project Inspection. On May 27, 2021, the Administration issued a Verbal Exit Briefing Report, followed by the issuance of a Notice of Amendment (“NOA”) on June 8, 2021.

The Company appreciates the opportunity to respond to the Administration’s NOA:

- In March 2021, the Company issued a revised LNG-AP-1013 (see Attachment A) to include retention of records pertaining to Section 6.6.5 of NFPA-59A-2001. This document was previously submitted to the Administration on May 11, 2021 as an attachment to IA Question 46 under DC-Equipment (Ref. No. DC.EQUIP.MATERLRECORDS.P).
- For the Administration’s reference, the Company is also including Eversource’s Operating Manual- Section 1.3. (see Attachment B) that includes retention of records pertaining to Section 6.6.5 of NFPA-59A-2001.
