On August 31, 2020, September 1, 2020 and September 4, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC's (Columbia) procedures for conducting operations, maintenance, and emergency preparedness and responses activities. As a result of the inspection, Columbia was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 7, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Columbia submitted its amended procedures on November 4, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
