This letter is in response to the March 15, 2022 Notice of Amendment Letter (Letter) provided to Equitrans Midstream Corporation (Equitrans) by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA). The following information and associated attachments serve as Equitrans' response to the Letter:

PHMSA Inspection Item No. 1

Equitrans revised Section 9 of the Equitrans Integrity Management Program for Underground Gas Storage (SIMP) and Section 2.1.8 of Equitrans Emergency Plan to address third party emergencies. Equitrans Emergency Operating Procedure (EOP-134), Responding to a Storage Well Emergency will be invoked in response to a third-party emergency.

PHMSA Inspection Item No. 2

Equitrans has conducted Emergency response drill(s) to evaluate the effectiveness of the Emergency Response Plan. Equitrans Integrity Management Program for Underground Gas Storage (SIMP) has been updated to reflect the Emergency Response Drills that are conducted. The drills are conducted on a 3-year rotation per field(s), determined by geographical location and responsible operation representative(s). Employees will be given a scenario that requires Equitrans Emergency Response procedures be invoked and followed. In 2021, Equitrans conducted one drill in West Virginia and one drill in Pennsylvania. The drills are conducted by Equitrans' Storage Integrity group.
