Dear Ms. Poppe:

On November 8, 2021, through November 15, 2021, an inspector from California Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM), acting as an agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Pacific Gas & Electric Co's procedures in Pleasant Creek, McDonald Island and Los Medanos Storage facilities in Yolo County, San Joaquin County, and Contra Costa County (respectively) California.. As a result of the inspection, Pacific Gas & Electric Co's was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 18, 2022, with a request for further information on December 22, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Pacific Gas & Electric Co submitted its amended procedures on October 27, 2022 for the Notice of Amendment dated August 18, 2022, and responded to the Request for Further Amendment on January 20, 2023 in response to the Request for Further Amendment dated December 22, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
