On July 11, 2022, through July 15, 2022, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of inspected Granite State Gas Transmission Inc.'s (Granite) procedures. As a result of the inspection, Granite was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 17, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
