From November 2, 2021, through July 22, 2022, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC's (TCO) procedures for compliance with new rule titled Pipeline Safety: Safety of Gas Transmission Pipelines: MAOP Reconfirmation, Expansion of Assessment Requirements, and Other Related Amendments, in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, TCO was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 4, 2023, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

TCO submitted its amended procedures on June 2, 2023. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
