On July 28, 2023, and on August 15, 2023, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued a Corrective Action Order (CAO) and an Amended Corrective Action Order (ACAO), respectively, to Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (CGT), with regard to the July 25, 2023 rupture of its 26-inch natural gas pipeline located in Strasburg, Virginia (Line VB). The ACAO included a list of various required Corrective Actions.

We have received the CAO Documentation Report (CDR). Additionally, we have also received quarterly reports, monthly reports, and other information.
