Dear Mr. Schlosser:

By letter dated March 28, 2024, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety, issued a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order (Notice) to Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals, LLC (Respondent).

In response to the Notice on April 25, 2024, Respondent requested a formal hearing and an informal settlement meeting. PHMSA held several meetings with KMLT between April, 2024 through October, 2024. On October 10, 2024, Respondent withdrew its request for hearing. On October 10, 2024, PHMSA and Respondent entered into a Consent Order which incorporated the terms of the Consent Agreement between PHMSA and Respondent.

The Consent Order included a Compliance Order and Civil Penalty. On October 18, 2024, Respondent paid the Civil Penalty. On December 10, 2024, Respondent issued to PHMSA the completed action items from the Compliance Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
